SCHOLARSHIPS FOR EX-FORM IV STUDENTS WISHING TO CLIMB MOUNT KILIMANJARO



1 BARBRO JOHANSSON GIRLS' EDUCATION TRUST (JOHA TRUST) is pleased to announce that as part of its DOUBLE anniversary celebrations for its two schools, 20 years for **BARBRO** in Dar es Salaam and 10 years for **KAJUMULO** in Bukoba, will be organizing a leadership training course for Ex-Form IV students who wish to climb Mount Kilimanjaro in cooperation with the Kilimanjaro Initiative (KLI).

2 The Kilimanjaro Initiative, founded by Geneva based Timothy Challen, is a not-for-profit organization based in Kenya. It works with urban youths in depressed neighborhoods and each year in February organizes a youth camp through which it sponsors youths in general to climb Mt Kilimanjaro as part of its values and leadership training program at the legendary Outward Bound Mountain School in Loitokitok, Kenya.

3 Scholarship places offered are limited and will be merit based for students who are at least 18 years old and shall register for advanced level studies at Barbro School to commence in July, 2020. The Barbro School spans from Form I to Form VI and offers all subject combinations in arts, sciences and commercial subjects. The Barbro school has become a pioneer on the mainland to offer the new PMC combination (Physics, Mathematics and Computers). Both Schools model modern values based education where students cannot be subjected to corporal punishment, and once admitted, cannot be screened for their academic performance. Focus is on best efforts to match a student's full potential. Students are also encouraged to be team players and taught to build self-confidence, self-discipline and strong will power as a way of life. Climbing a mountain is a test for all these characteristics. Yet, this liberal stance has not prevented the school from being a high performer academically year in year out. 4 For those who wish, Pre-form V classes shall run for 4 months until the school closes on 6 June 2020 to open again on 4 July. In order not to miss this golden opportunity Pre-form Five Studies at Barbro School this year shall start early, on 1st February, 2020. Girls wishing to climb Mount Kilimanjaro either under scholarship or self-sponsored should therefore report at **Barbro in Dar es Salaam on 1st February, 2020**. Students should report with uniforms, sports-wear and other useful educational materials from their old secondary schools or with pocket money to get basic education supplies from the school shop. For those making a commitment to register for Form V either at **Barbro or Kajumulo schools**, the cost for Pre-Form V is virtually free. This is so because half of the Pre Form V fees (Shs 150,000/= per month for the program) shall be deductible from the ordinary school fees payable when Form V classes start. Students wishing to do only Pre Form V studies at Barbro but opt to go to other schools are also welcome but the Preform V fees paid shall be non-refundable.

5 The program is flexible. Students can report for Pre-Form V studies anytime between 1st February and latest 5th May, a month before school closes. Fees are payable proportional to the months attended, such that one month is Shs. 150,000/=; 2 months Shs 300,000/=; 3 months Shs 450,000/= and 4 months Shs 600,000/=

6 Apart from the Kilimanjaro Mountain climb, the 4 months long Pre-Form V program at Barbro this year, as part of the anniversary festivities, shall be punctuated by a series of study tours to various Tanzania national parks, as shall be dictated by student demand and affordability.
